Ambassador Daalder is a widely-published author. His most recent books include; In the Shadow of the Oval Office: Profiles of the National Security Advisers and the Presidents They Served. From JFK to George W. Bush (with I.M. Destler) and the award-winning American Unbound: The Bush Revolution in Foreign Policy (with James M. Lindsay). Other books include Beyond Preemption: Force and Legitimacy in a Changing World (2007); Crescent of Crisis: US-European Strategy for the Greater Middle East (2006); and Winning Ugly: NATO's War to Save Kosovo (2000). Ambassador Daalder is a frequent contributor to the opinion pages of the world's leading newspapers, and a regular commentator on international affairs on television and radio.

Before his appointment as ambassador to NATO by President Obama in 2009, Daalder was a senior fellow in foreign policy studies at the Brookings Institution, specializing in American foreign policy, European security and transatlantic relations, and national security affairs.
