Dariush Mozaffarian, M.D.

Dean, Friedman School of Nutrition Scinece & Policy Tufts University Friday, February 5, 2021

Dariush Mozaffarian is a cardiologist, Dean and Jean Mayer Professor at the Tufts Friedman School of Nutrition Science and Policy, and Professor of Medicine at Tufts Medical School. As one of the top nutrition institutions in the world, the Friedman School's mission is to produce trusted science, future leaders,

and real-world impact. Dr. Mozaffarian has authored more than 400 scientific publications on dietary priorities for obesity, diabetes, and cardiovascular diseases, and on evidence-based policy approaches to reduce these burdens in the U.S. and globally. He has served in numerous advisory roles including for the U.S. and Canadian governments, American Heart Association, World Health Organization, and United Nations. His work has been featured in a wide array of media outlets including the *New York Times, Washington Post, Wall Street Journal, National Public Radio*, and *Time Magazine*. In 2016, Thomson Reuters named him as one of the World's Most Influential Scientific Minds.

Dr. Mozaffarian received a B.S. in biological sciences at Stanford (Phi Beta Kappa), M.D. at Columbia, residency training in internal medicine at Stanford, and fellowship training in cardiovascular medicine at the University of Washington. He also received an M.P.H. from the University of Washington and a Doctorate in Public Health from Harvard. Before being appointed as Dean at Tufts in 2014, Dr. Mozaffarian was at Harvard Medical School and Harvard School of Public Health for a decade and clinically active in cardiology at Brigham and Women's Hospital. He is married, has three children, and actively trains as a Third Degree Black Belt in Taekwondo.

Rahm Emanuel

Rahm Emanuel served as the 55th mayor of the City of Chicago from 2011-2019. Emanuel previously served as Chief of Staff to President Obama, where he helped secure the passage of landmark legislation, including the unprecedented stimulus package that ushered the country through the great recession and the passage of the Affordable Care Act. From 2003 to 2009, Emanuel served in the U.S. House of Representatives, where he held a number of leadership positions, including Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee chairman and Democratic Caucus chairman. Emanuel served as director of the finance committee of Bill Clinton's 1992

presidential campaign and later as Assistant to the President for political affairs and Senior Advisor for policy and strategy.

Rahm Emanuel is currently a senior advisor at Centerview Partners and a contributor for *ABC News*. Rahm Emanuel is married to Amy Rule and they have three children.



Gwynne Shotwell President & COO SpaceX Friday, February 26, 2021

As President and COO of SpaceX, Gwynne Shotwell is responsible for the day-to-day operations and managing all customer and strategic relations to support company growth. She joined SpaceX in 2002 as Vice President of

Business Development and built the Falcon vehicle family manifest to more than 100 launches, representing more than \$15 billion in business. Shotwell is a member of the SpaceX Board of Directors.

Prior to joining SpaceX, Shotwell spent more than 10 years at the Aerospace Corporation, holding positions in Space Systems Engineering, Technology and Project Management. She was promoted to the role of Chief Engineer of an MLV-class satellite program, managed a landmark study for the Federal Aviation Administration in commercial space transportation, and completed and extensive analysis of space policy for NASA's future investment in space transportation.

In addition to being included on Time's 100 Most Influential People of 2020, Shotwell was awarded the 2020 Von Karmen Wings award. In 2018, Shotwell was named the Satellite Executive of the Year and Mechanical Engineers Ralph Coats Roe Medal. *Fortune Magazine* placed Shotwell at #42 on their list of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders in 2018 and *Forbes* named her #55 on their list of Power Women in 2019. She was inducted into the National Academy of Engineering in 2020 and in 2019 was appointed to the National Space Council Users' Advisory Group. In 2014, Shotwell was appointed to the United States Export Import Bank's Advisory Committee and the Federal Aviation Administration's Management Advisory Council. Shotwell was elected to the honorable grade of Fellow with the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics.

Through leadership in both corporate and external science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) programs, Shotwell has

Shotwell received, with honors, her bachelor's and master's degrees from Northwestern University in Mechanical Engineering and Applied Mathematics, and serves on their Board. She has authored dozens of papers on a variety of space related subjects.
