David MacLennan is the 9th CEO of Cargill and has served in that capacity since 2013. He was first elected to the Cargill Board of Directors in 2008.

He began his Cargill career in 1991 in Cargill's Financial Markets

Division in Cargill's Minneapolis and London offices and became Chief Financial Officer in 2008, and Chief Operating Officer in 2011.

Prior to joining Cargill, MacLennan began his career in the futures and securities sector in Chicago, and was president of fixed income capital markets at USBancorp Piper Jaffray in Minneapolis.

Outside of Cargill, MacLennan serves on the boards of Ecolab (ECL), Caterpillar (CAT), the Minnesota Business Partnership, Amherst College and on The Business Council's executive committee. His non-profit board service has included Youth Frontiers and College Possible, in support of his passion for the needs of under-privileged youth and their access to education. He holds a bachelor's degree in English from Amherst College and an M.B.A. in finance from the University of Chicago.

He and his wife, Kathleen, have been married for 35 years and have 3 adult children. They have owned a place in Naples since 1999, and have been coming to the area since the early 90's.

H. R. McMaster is the Fouad and Michelle Ajami Senior Fellow at the Hoover Institution, Stanford University. He is also the Bernard and Susan Liautaud Fellow at the Freeman Spogli Institute and lecturer at Stanford University's Graduate School of Business. He

serves as the Japan Chair at the Hudson Institute and Chairman of the Center for Political and Military Power at the Foundation for Defense of Democracy. He was the 26th assistant to the president for National Security Affairs. McMaster served as a commissioned officer in the United States Army for thirty-four years after graduation from West Point. He holds a PhD in military history from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He is author of Battlegrounds: The Fight to Defend the Free World and Dereliction of Duty: Lyndon Johnson, Robert McNamara, the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the Lies that Led to Vietnam. He is host of the podcast Battlegrounds: International Perspectives on Crucial Challenges to Security and Prosperity.

Douglas E. Vaughan, M.D.

Dr. Vaughan is chairman of the Department of Medicine and the Irving S. Cutter Professor of Medicine in the Division of

Cardiology at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. He is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology and has been elected to membership in the American Society for Clinical Investigation and the Association of American Physicians.

As a principal clinical investigator, Dr. Vaughan spans the bench to the bedside in his work. His efforts and findings in vascular biology include basic investigations into regulation of gene expression, genetic models of disease, mechanistic studies in humans, and clinical trials. His primary research interests are in the mammalian plasminogen activator system and the role this system plays in cardiovascular disease and physiological aging.

In 2018, Dr. Vaughan led a study that reported the first genetic variation that appears to protect against multiple aspects of biological aging in humans in an extended kindred of Old Order Amish living in the vicinity of Berne, Indiana.

Dr. Vaughan now leads the recently launched Potoscnak Longevity Institute, bringing together scientists and experts across many disciplines to study those populations that seem resistant to negative consequences of aging with a goal of discovering what makes them unique. With a deeper understanding of how aging works, the institute aims to expand the healthspan for all people with future therapies and lifestyle interventions.
