NASA Astronaut,
U.S. Navy SEAL

U.S. Navy Captain Chris Cassidy served 11 years as a Navy SEAL. He received his B.S. from the U.S. Naval Academy and a Master's degree in ocean engineering from MIT in 2000. During his service with the SEALs, he earned two Bronze Stars for leading a nine-day operation at the Zharwar Kili cave complex in Afghanistan – a national priority

objective. Beside making four, six-month deployments to Afghanistan and two to the Mediterranean, Cassidy also volunteered for, and completed, a week-long, 180-mile charity kayak paddle to raise awareness for the Special Operations Warrior Foundation.

In May 2004, Cassidy was selected for the space program by NASA. In February, 2006 he completed Astronaut Candidate Training and served in the astronaut corps for 17 years. In his career, he accumulated 378 days in space. Of that time, he spent 54 hours, 51 minutes outside of the International Space Station over the course of 10 spacewalks.

Cassidy considers York, Maine his hometown and is married with three children.

Dr. Larry P. Arnn12th President of Hillsdale College
Friday, February 17, 2023 **Hilton Naples**

Larry P. Arnn is the 12th president of Hillsdale College, where he is also a professor of politics and history. He received his B.A. from Arkansas State University and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Government from the Claremont Graduate School. He also studied at Worcester College, Oxford University, where he served as director of research for Sir Martin Gilbert, the official biographer of Winston Churchill. From 1985 to 2000,

he served as president of the Claremont Institute for the Study of Statesmanship and Political Philosophy. In 1996, he was the founding chairman of the California Civil Rights Initiative, which prohibited racial preferences in state hiring, contracting, and admissions. Dr. Arnn is on the board of directors of The Heritage Foundation, the Henry Salvatori Center of Claremont McKenna College, The Philadelphia Society, the Intercollegiate Studies Institute, and the Claremont Institute. He served on the U.S. Army War College Board of Visitors for two years, for which he earned the Department of the Army's "Outstanding Civilian Service Medal." In 2015, he received the Bradley Prize from the Lynde and Harry Bradley Foundation. Dr. Arnn is the author of three books: *Liberty* and Learning: The Evolution of American Education; The Founder's Key: The Divine and Natural Connection Between the Declaration and the Constitution and What We Risk by Losing It; and Churchill's Trail: Winston Churchill and the Salvation of Free Government.

He and his wife, Penelope, have four children, Henry, Katy, Alice and Tony, and two grandchildren, Charlotte and William.
