# **David Abney**

Mr. David Abney, who began his career as a part-time package loader while in college, serves as CEO and Chairman of the Board of UPS. He was appointed CEO in 2014 and as chairman in 2016.

#### **Michael Pillsbury**

Director Chinese Strategy Hudson Institute Naples Beach Hotel, Everglades Dining Room Friday, January 25, 2019



Senior Fellow and Director for Chinese Strategy, Michael Pillsbury is a distinguished defense policy advisor, former high-ranking government official and author of numerous books on China. During the Reagan administration, Pillsbury was Assistant Under Secretary of Defense for Policy Planning and responsible for implementation of the program of covert aid known as the Reagan Doctrine.

Pillsbury served on the staff of four U.S. Senate Committees from 1978-1984. He assisted in drafting the legislation to create the National Endowment for Democracy and the

annual requirement for a DOD report on Chinese military power. In 1992, under President George H. W. Bush, Pillsbury was Special Assistant for Asian Affairs in the Office of the Secretary of Defense.

Pillsbury is the author of China Debates the Future Security Environment, The Hundred-Year Marathon: China's Secret Strategy to Replace America as the Global Superpower, and editor of Chinese Views of Future Warfare.

Pillsbury was educated at Stanford University (B.A. in History) and Columbia University (M.A. and Ph.D.)
