General Bob Kehler retired from the United States Air Force in December 2013 after almost 39 years of distinguished service. From January 2011 until November 2013 he served as the Commander, United States Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM), where he was directly responsible to the Secretary

of Defense and president for the plans and operations of all U.S. forces conducting strategic deterrence, nuclear alert, global strike, space, cyberspace and associated operations.

Prior to commanding STRATCOM, the general commanded United States Air Force Space Command and two operational space wings responsible for space launch, missile warning and space control. He also commanded an intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM) squadron and operations group.

General Kehler entered the Air Force in 1975 as a distinguished graduate of the Pennsylvania State University R.O.T.C. program, has master's degrees in Public Administration and National Security and Strategic Studies, and completed executive development programs at Carnegie-Mellon University, Syracuse University and Harvard University. General Kehler was the S.T. Lee Distinguished Lecturer at Stanford University's Freeman Spogli Institute for International Studies for academic year 2014-2015, and remains an affiliate of Stanford's Center for International Security and Cooperation.

General Kehler's decorations include Defense Distinguished Service Medal, Distinguished Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, Defense Superior Service Medal and French Legion of Honor (Officer).
