

Edward M. Liddy served as a partner in the private equity investment firm Clayton, Dubilier & Rice, LLC from January 2010 to December 2015.

Mr. Liddy served as Chairman of The Allstate Corporation (Allstate) from January 1999 until his retirement in April 2008, and as Chief Executive Officer from 1999 until December 2006. He was President and Chief Operating Officer from August 1994 until December 1998.

At the request of the U.S. Government, in September 2008 Mr. Liddy agreed to serve as interim Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of American International Group, Inc. (AIG), a global insurance and financial services holding

company, in conjunction with the U. S. Government's actions to provide stability to certain financial service firms. After stabilizing the company and initiating a plan to repay government assistance extended to AIG, Mr. Liddy returned to private life in August 2009.

Mr. Liddy serves on the board of directors of 3M Company, The Boeing Company, Abbott Laboratories and AbbVie Inc.

A dedicated philanthropist, Liddy currently serves on the board of Northwestern University. He is a life trustee and chairman emeritus of Northwestern Memorial Hospital, a life trustee of the Museum of Science and Industry, and a life trustee and former national chairman of the Boys & Girls Clubs of America. He currently Chairs the Commercial Club of Chicago.

Mr. Özgür Kıvanç Altan is the Consul General of the Republic of Turkey in Miami. He recently served as the Deputy Chief of Mission at the Turkish Embassy in Athens, Greece.

Prior to this, he served in NATO and international security issues related positions for over seven years (Head of Department, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, 2010-2012; Counselor, Turkish Permanent Delegation to NATO, 2006-2010; and Head of Section, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, 2005-2006). From 2001-2004, Mr. Altan was the Vice-Consul of the Turkish Consulate General in Los Angeles, California.

He was a political advisor with the international staff at the Office of the High Representative in Sarajevo (2000-2001) and as 3rd Secretary in the Turkish Embassy (1999-2000) in Sarajevo. From 1996-1999, Mr. Altan served as attaché to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkey, Balkans Department. Consul General studied political science at the University of Ankara and completed the NATO Defense College in Rome, Italy.

He is fluent in English and Turkish and has various levels of knowledge of Greek, French, German and Serbo-Croat language. He is married and has a daughter.
