A Pulitzer Prize-nominated cartoonist, Payne produces six local cartoons a week for The News, and six national cartoons for clients via United Feature Syndicate in New York. His cartoons are reprinted in publications from USA Today to Townhall.com to The Washington Times. He has been awarded Michigan's Best Editorial Cartoonist by the Associated Press and a runner-up for the Mencken Award for Editorial Cartooning.

Payne is founder and editor of The Michigan View.com, a conservative website covering Michigan. The site is Michigan's premier commentary site featuring the state's best writers.

Payne is also a correspondent for National Review magazine on auto and regulatory issues. He is an occasional contributor to The Wall Street Journal, the Weekly Standard magazine, Reason Magazine, The New York Post, San Francisco Chronicle, and other
