ALFRED F. KELLY, JR.

CEO

Alfred F. Kelly, Jr is Chief Executive Officer of Visa, a global payments technology company. Prior to his role, he was President and Chief Executive Officer of Intersection, a private Alphabet-backed technology and digital media company.

Before joining Intersection, Mr. Kelly served as a Management Advisor to TowerBrook, a London and

New York-based investment management firm. He advised TowerBrook on current portfolio companies and contributed to due diligence on prospective deals.

Additionally, for most of 2015, Mr. Kelly served as the full-time Chairman of the Papal visit to New York City. In that capacity, Mr. Kelly worked closely with Cardinal Timothy Michael Dolan and the U.S. Secret Service and oversaw all aspects of the planning. Mr. Kelly assembled and led a team which managed all movements and events for Pope Francis' two-day stay in late September, 2015.

In September of 2014, Mr. Kelly completed a three-and-a-half-year tenure as Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of the 2014 NY/NJ Super Bowl Host Company (SBHC), which raised a record \$80 million to fund regional support of the Game, and raised an additional record \$13 million plus in its charitable foundation to improve facilities used by school age children. The SBHC also fostered incredible local interest which catapulted the game's ratings in the NY market resulting in Super Bowl XLVIII being the most watched show in U.S. television history.

Before the SBHC experience, Mr. Kelly spent 23 years at the American Express Company. As president of the American Express Company for his last three and a half years, Mr. Kelly worked closely with the chairman and CEO to develop the strategic direction for the company and determine key policies. He led day-to-day global operations for the American Express consumer businesses. Before that Mr.

Kelly served as one of two Group Presidents at American Express, overseeing key domestic business units.

In the years that Mr. Kelly led the U.S. card business, the business gained market share every year and, over a ten-year period, sales volume, revenue and pre-tax income grew an average of ten percent plus per year. American Express became the sales volume leader in the marketplace and was the only large card issuer to achieve its volume levels totally through organic growth.

Mr. Kelly joined American Express' Strategic Planning department in 1987. He rose to Vice President of Technologies in 1988 and held a series of increasingly senior positions in planning, marketing operations and marketing until reaching President of the U.S. consumer card business in 1998.

Before joining American Express, Mr. Kelly held senior positions in government and private industry. A leader in information systems and technology, he was head of Information Systems at the White House from 1985 to 1987, where he led the information processing functions for eight of the agencies that comprise the Executive Office of the President. From 1981 to 1985, he held a series of positions at PepsiCo in information systems and strategic and financial planning.

Mr. Kelly is a member of the Board of Directors of MetLife, Inc. and Visa, Inc., the Board of Trustees of New York-Presbyterian Hospital where he is a member of the Executive Committee, Boston College, St. Joseph's Seminary and College, and, the New York Catholic Foundation. He is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and he has served for the past 25 years as a chairman of the Wall Street Charity Golf Classic, a major fundraiser for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. He was, for 13 years, a trustee of Iona College and was chairman of its Development Committee. He served for four years as the first Co-Chair of the President's Roundtable at Boston College.

He received a B.A. (Summa Cum Laude) and an MBA with Honors from Iona College. Mr. Kelly resides with his wife, Peggy, in New York's Westchester County. They have five children.
