Mary Sue Coleman is president emerita of the University of Michigan, an institution she led for 12 years before retiring in July 2014.

Time magazine named her one of the nation's "10 best college presidents," and the American Council on Education honored her with its Lifetime Achievement Award.

At the University of Michigan, she unveiled several major initiatives designed to have an impact on future generations of students, the intellectual life of the campus, and society at large. These initiatives included the interdisciplinary richness of the university, student residential life, the economic vitality of the state and nation, global engagement, and the value of innovation.

She continues to be a recognized higher education leader at the national level. She co-chairs the Lincoln Project, an initiative of the American Academy of Arts & Sciences to preserve the strength and diversity of public research universities. She also serves on the Board of Trustees of the Society for Science & the Public, a nonprofit organization dedicated to public engagement in scientific research and education.

She is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Kavli Foundation, which promotes science and support for scientists; the Board of Trustees of the Gates Cambridge Scholars, a graduate fellowship program; and the Board of Trustees of the Mayo Clinic.

Elected to the Institute of Medicine, Dr. Coleman also is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. She holds a Ph.D. in biochemistry from the University of North Carolina and a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Grinnell College.
