Dr. John H. Noseworthy is the medical director of the Mayo Clinic Department of Development and a professor in the Department of Neurology. He is a vice chair of the Mayo Clinic Rochester Executive Board and recently led the "Mayo Clinic 2020" task force to help establish long-term institutional direction.

Born in Melrose, Massachusetts, he received the M.D. degree from Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova

Scotia, Canada, completed his neurology training at Dalhousie University and the University of Western Ontario and a research fellowship at Harvard Medical School. In 1990 he joined Mayo Clinic and served as chair of the Department of Neurology from 1997 to 2006.

He specializes in multiple sclerosis, a field he contributed

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to for more than two decades in the design and conduct of controlled clinical trials receiving research funding from the National Multiple Sclerosis Society (USA), the National Institutes of Health, the Medical Research Council of Canada and the Multiple Sclerosis Society of Canada. He played a pivotal role in founding the Sylvia Lawry Centre for Multiple Sclerosis Research in Munich, Germany in 2001 for the purpose of advancing research into effective therapies for this illness. He is the author of more than 150 research papers, chapters and editorials and is the author or editor of several books including the three volume textbook "Neurological Therapeutics: Principles and Practice" now in its second edition. He is currently the editor-in-chief of Neurology, the official journal of the American Academy of Neurology.

Dr. Noseworthy and his wife Patricia have two sons, Peter and Mark.

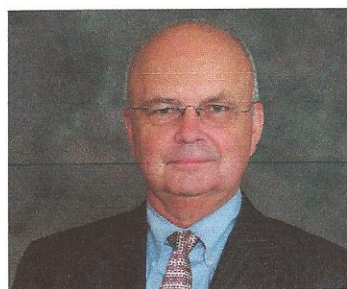

CIA, General Hayden served as the country's first Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence - and was the highest-ranking intelligence office in the armed forces. Earlier, he served as Commander of the Air Intelligence Agency, Director of the Joint Command and Control Warfare Center, Director of the National Security Agency and Chief of the Central Security Service. General Hayden graduated from Duquesne University with a bachelor's degree in history in 1967 and a master's degree in modern American history in 1969. He was a distinguished graduate of the university's ROTC program, and began his active military service in 1969. He also did postgraduate work at the Defense Intelligence School conducted by the Defense Intelligence Agency. General Hayden has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal, the Legion of Merit and the Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters.
