### **Abdullah Sharif**

With three decades of international consulting as an aviation engineer in America and Europe, and since 2009 as a peace diplomat for the U.S. Departments of State and Defense, Mr. Sharif is committed to peace-building efforts for the international community.

Mr. Sahrif was born in Afghanistan during the latter part of its Golden Age, 1930 to the mid-1970s. Originally from the southern region of Kandahar, Sharif's forebears, the Mohammadzais, left for Kabul to help govern Afghanistan over a hundred and fifty years ago. Mr. Sharif's father sacrificed family life to serve as brigade commander to protect the country's eastern border with Pakistan in the early 1960s, while his family remained in

Kabul.

Mr. Sharif left Afghanistan in November 1976 and never set foot there again until thirty years later as an American citizen. What he saw and experienced broke his heart, especially having grown up with a happy childhood in Kabul, the capital city.

Half a century later, Mr. Sharif returned as a civilian on behalf of his adopted country-similarly striving to bring peace to Afghans five decades after his father's and others' efforts.

Mr. Sharif has received awards including the U.S. Department of State's Superior Honor Award for "extraordinary contribution to the U.S. effort to bring peace and prosperity to the people of Afghanistan," 2010; the U.S. Department of State's
